Tasting Notes

The 2021 Rose is a blend of fruit from a variety of sites and growers that we source from to craft our varietal designated wines, including Carneros and Oak Knoll District. To enhance the complexity of this Rose, we blended a total of 8 different varietals into this year's rendition. It makes for a delightful rose that is full of high-toned red fruit. Strawberry, raspberry, and cherry are abundant on the nose and palate, that are carried by a crisp texture and refreshing acid.

Winemaking Notes

We keep the alcohol low, the acid high, and the color as light as possible to make a Rose that is drinkable and fresh as possible. Serve chilled, and young while it still has vibrant acidity and light color.

2021 was one of the earliest vintages ever for Napa. The warm growing season was without any major weather events which allowed us to pick on our own preferred schedule. The result is a crop of fruit with small berries that are super concentrated and produce wines with remarkable intensity. While yields were significantly down, the quality is truly exceptional.
