## Tasting Notes

This bold yet approachable red opens with inviting aromas of jammy dark fruit, ripe cherry, and red plum, creating an immediate sense of warmth and generosity. Subtle layers of leather, violet, and soft florals lend depth and intrigue, balancing the wine's fruit-forward nature with a touch of sophistication. The bouquet hints at both richness and charm, promising a palate that's as expressive as it is easy to enjoy.

On the palate, the wine delivers smooth, juicy textures supported by polished tannins and a vibrant core of red and black fruit. Hints of spice and dried herbs add complexity, while the finish remains bright and fruit-driven, leaving a lingering impression of cherry and plum preserves. Its supple structure and balanced acidity make it a versatile and crowd-pleasing red that's equally at home on a casual table or at a festive gathering.

This wine shines with comforting, flavorful dishes that highlight its bold yet approachable style. Pair it with braised short ribs, grilled lamb chops, or herb-roasted chicken for a savory complement. For a more relaxed pairing, try it alongside wood-fired pizza with Italian sausage, mushroom risotto, or a hearty pasta Bolognese. Its juicy fruit and velvety finish also make it a wonderful partner for aged cheeses or dark chocolate desserts, rounding out an effortless and satisfying experience.
